Steps to be Taken in Case Material is Released or Spilled -

Caution, slip hazard. Wipe up small spills promptly with a rag or other absorbent material. For large spills, isolate and ventilate area. Eliminate all ignition sources. Wear protective gear as necessary. Dike to prevent spread. Pick up with an absorbent material and put in suitable container for proper disposal.

Waste Disposal Method -

Consult local, state, and federal regulations. Triple rinse empty container then offer for recycling, reuse, or reconditioning.

Precautions to be Taken in Handling and Storing -

Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Avoid inhaling vapors. Do not swallow. Wash thoroughly after handling.
